


Road Safety Policy



For STRACON it is essential to promote, implement and maintain practices for the prevention and reduction of road risks, therefore, senior management is committed to establish mechanisms for the prevention of accidents on public and private roads, therefore, direct personnel, contractors and suppliers of STRACON, are responsible for participating in activities aimed at mitigating traffic accidents that may occur during operations and affect people, equipment, facilities, or the environment.

To this end, STRACON relies on the following measures:

1. To comply with the regulations established in the National Traffic Code and concordant regulations, which are framed in principles of safety, quality, the preservation of a healthy environment and the protection of public space.
2. To comply with the Client's and STRACON's Internal Traffic Regulations in the project where the services are performed.
3. Oversee the responsibility for preventive and corrective maintenance of its own vehicles, contractors and suppliers, in order to maintain optimum performance of its vehicles, establishing control measures to prevent the occurrence of accidents and incidents that may cause injury or damage.
4. Define awareness-raising strategies for all employees and suppliers through learning scenarios aimed at preventing traffic accidents, respecting traffic signals and complying with regulations that allow for the acceptance of safe behaviors regarding preventive and defensive driving.
5. Allocate the necessary financial, human and technical resources to comply with this Policy and the Strategic Road Safety Plan in order to guarantee the principle of continuous improvement.
